



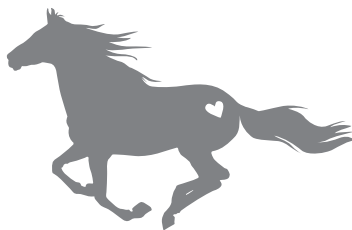

# *Round-Up Events*

The Round-Up Horse Show showcases RED Arena participants performances and competitions in different events.

## **IN HAND HALTER COURSE**

Participants in the job training program showcase their skills leading and working horses through arena obstacles. Participants must demonstrate calm energy and focus to successfully lead the horses. This helps with horse training and is good physical activity for both the horse and participant.

## **ARENA RACE**

This competition is for riders of all ability levels to demonstrate their riding skills including core strength for sitting tall, balancing, reaching, visually tracking, communication with horse and team, motor planning & sequencing and/or reining/steering the horse. Place ribbons are awarded for each heat.

## **TRAIL OBSTACLES**

Riders are scored on riding skills and/or their tricks on horseback through various trail obstacle challenges. Thank you to our trail judges, the veterinarians and staff from Austin Equine Hospital.

## **RED ARENA DRILL TEAM**

Riders who have progressed to independent riding display their skills in this team event. The team works together to learn and execute a riding pattern. Attention and focus are required to remember the pattern and keep safe spacing between the horses.

# History

RED (Riding Equines for the Disabled) Arena is a PATH Premier Accredited Therapeutic Riding Center that was founded in Dripping Springs in 2008 by Physical Therapist & CEO Jennifer Young, PT and Board Members Myrna Young, Kerry Ugarte and Catherine Cacioppo. RED Arena's mission is to EMPOWER individuals with disabilities through horses. In the Fall of 2018 RED Arena celebrated the grand opening of its second location in San Marcos. Then in 2020, thanks to a one-million-dollar donation from Mariam McCoy in honor of her late husband, the founder of McCoy's Building Supply, Emmett McCoy, the land was purchased and construction began for the Dripping Springs arena. Donations from the Allison Family, Mabee Foundation, the Ward Orsinger Legacy Grant, Castleman Family and Young Family allowed construction to continue debt free through 2021 with enough being completed to start programs in the Fall of 2021. # *RED Arena's Programs*

Your support today is helping serve over 200 kids & adults each week who benefit from our programs.

## **EQUINE ASSISTED PHYSICAL THERAPY**

The dynamic movement of the horse facilitates improved balance, posture, range of motion, mobility, gross and fine motor skills, communication, confidence and self-esteem. Care is provided by licensed physical therapists with advanced training through American Hippotherapy Association.

## **THERAPEUTIC RIDING**

The goal for all our participants is to progress to riding as independently as possible while continuing to benefit physically, cognitively and emotionally from being on the horse. Our PATH-certified Instructors provide quality individual riding lessons for all ages and ability levels in our wonderful arena and on our beautiful trails, with as little or as much support as needed. Lessons include riding, horse care and tacking.

## **BEGINNER RIDING LESSONS**

As part of our sibling support programs riding lessons are offered as an activity with the horses that siblings can enjoy together.

## **EQUINE FACILITATED LEARNING**

**REDy to Read** – Reading to the mini horses is a fun way to build confidence as well as foster learning. Sessions include reading to the mini horse with time for brushing the horse as well.

**Job Training** - Sessions for barn management and horse care with an emphasis on team work & social skills that can transfer to any employment setting.

## **VOCATIONAL PROGRAM & GIFT SHOP**

The Dripping Springs location has expanded the Job Training program for adults with disabilities to offer more intensive functional opportunities for creation, social skills, self-care, fitness and retail shop experience. The program runs 4 hours daily with options for one to four days per week. The beautiful seasonal crafts created by our "RED PROs" in this program are sold in the gift shop. Proceeds from the gift shop support this program.

## **SUMMER HORSE CAMP**

Inclusive horse camp for kids of ALL ability levels. The day includes group trail rides, hands on horse care, gross motor games, fine motor crafts and an emphasis on social communication, fun and acceptance. Camp is open to participants, siblings and the community.
